Promotion & Advertising – Increase the profile of the L&J games

- 1. Clubs & county boards must actively recruit, promote and welcome new members in.
- 2. Create dedicated sections on the PPUI Website for L&J.
- 3. Create dedicated PPUI L&J Facebook page PPUI Ladies and Juveniles
- 4. Create dedicated email address for L&J ladiesjuveniles@ppui.ie
- 5. Launch a dedicated Backspin edition for L&J in Q1 2019
- 6. Greater use of social media e.g Instagram, YouTube, videos plus print media.
- 7. Seek sponsorships specifically targeted at L&J
- 8. Use Ladies Social Day as platform to heavily advertise and promote the game
- 9. Continue the International Challenges only for L&J, offer place for Ladies and U16 on Irish teams.
- 10.NEC office continue to offer support to club for promotion and recruiting



Ladies Competitions – Recommendations for 2019

- 1. Clubs and Ladies must actively encourage entries into competitions.
- 2. Heavy promotion and reminders of upcoming Championship and Deadlines
- 3. Handicaps grades to be reviewed along with monitoring of the SSS
 - 1. At the end of 2018, 42 Senior, 233 Inters and 1098 Juniors (600 with handicap of 18+)
- 4. Introduction of net prizes into the National & Provincial Championships.
- 5. Critically review of competition formats
- 6. Same prizes for all grades and championships
- 7. Seek to enhance the social aspect around championships
- 8. NEC to select suitable courses with proper facilities
- 9. Coaching to be offered to Ladies aswell as Juveniles



Juvenile Competitions – Recommendations for 2019

Juveniles just want to Play! Clubs, County Board and NEC must provide more competition and opportunities for them to play

- 1. Maximum play at provincial and national championships.
- 2. Introduce handicaps for juveniles in 2019.
- 3. Continued reinforcement to clubs to take in Juvenile membership. Remove the perception or excuse its too difficulty and risky to do. Its not!
- 4. Regional Scratch Cups or opens for Juveniles
- 5. Develop club, county or regional academies
- 6. Combination & increased number of teams at intercounty to be allowed
- 7. Create formats to allow juveniles to play alongside adults



Increasing Ladies participation at administrative level

- 1. The NEC to introduce a new position of Ladies Officer at the NEC level.
- 2. NEC to require County Boards and Clubs to have a Ladies Officer positions.
- 3. Increased participation on sub committees

- **IMPORTANT:** Promotion, advertising, new initiatives and ideas along with the efforts of the NEC and this subcommittee can only do so much.
