PRACTICE DATES AND TIMES FOR NATIONAL STROKEPLAY

Junior qualifiers (Players only)

Tuesday 15th September all day

Wednesday 16th September all day

Thursday 17th September, the course will close at 4pm

Intermediate and Seniors (Players only)

Tuesday 22nd September all day

Wednesday 23rd September all day

Thursday 24th September, course will close at 2pm

- All players are asked to play 1 ball over 36 holes
- Please check in with the army policeman at the main barrack gate to gain entry.
- Upon entry we ask that all players sign in as it is the protocol before you play
- Please adhere to social distance guidelines while playing on the course
- Parking will be outside as there are no vehicles permitted into the Campfield
- Free parking is available all down the left side of the gate and across the road on the right side up from the main barrack gate
- If you park on the right side outside the Campfield gate you will require a parking disc
- Collins club would ask people to adhere to these dates as it will not be possible to practice before these dates because of restrictions put on the club by the army
- It is advisable to bring your Pitch and Putt Ireland registration card as you may be asked to produce it at the main gate
