

PPUI SAFEGUARDING TRAINING POLICY

This policy is part of the Safeguarding Statement for the Pitch and Putt Union of Ireland (PPUI) under the Children First Act 2015.

Under PPUI Safeguarding Policies and Procedures and in line with current legislation an individual whose role will have regular and ongoing contact with children or vulnerable adults in the provision of pitch and putt activities <u>must</u> complete safeguarding training. This policy sets out the accepted Safeguarding Workshops for the PPUI together with any specific requirements for attendance and renewal of certification.

Also outlined within this policy is a list of typical roles which require safeguarding training. A person assuming such a role within a club, County/Regional Board or the PPUI is required to attend the level which is appropriate for their role.

Safeguarding Training Levels

• Safeguarding 1 – Child Welfare & Protection Basic Awareness Course

This course educates participants on the implementation of best practice in protecting the welfare of children involved in sport. The workshop provides introductory information on codes of conduct, bullying, recruitment etc. as well as child protection guidelines. By following the principles, policy and practical guidelines contained in the Code, sports leaders are playing their part in providing a safe and enjoyable environment in which children can learn and thrive.

• Safeguarding 2 – Club Children's Officer Workshop

A person appointed to the Club Children's Officer position in a club must have completed the Safeguarding 1 workshop and should complete the Club Children's Officer Workshop The appointment of Club children's Officer is an essential element in the creation of a quality atmosphere for young people in your club. They act as a resource to members with regards to children's issues and ensure that children have a voice in the running of the club and can talk freely about their experiences. This course will help the Club Children's Officer to carry out the function of their role in the club and support the implementation of best practice in the club. Participants will also receive a Club Children's Officer Action Planning document as part of the training.

• Safeguarding 3 – Designated Liaison Person Workshop

A person appointed to the Designated Liaison Person position in a club must have completed the Safeguarding 1 workshop and should complete the Designated Liaison Person workshop. The designated Liaison Person will be the person responsible for dealing with any concerns about the protection of children. It is recommended that this person is a senior club person.

Roles Requiring Safeguarding Training

The following table outlines the roles within the PPUI and PPUI Affiliated Clubs that require a person to attend Safeguarding training and at what level.

Notes:

- It is the responsibility of the club or County/Regional Board to ensure that anyone working with or interacts with or is involved in the planning/administration of activities or events with juveniles holds a valid safeguarding training certificate.
- Validation period of certificates commences from the date of the workshop completion.
- Clubs should also ensure that the are compliant with the PPUI National Vetting Policy and that any individual working with juveniles has been vetted.

Safeguarding 1 Online Refresher Course

If you hold a valid Face to Face Safeguarding 1 Certificate you can renew your Safeguarding 1 Training online through the Sport Ireland e-learning resource. If you use the online refresher it is valid for another 3 years but for further renewal you must attend a Face to Face Safeguarding 1 course with the PPUI or your Local Sports Partnership.
